

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

MORE THAN GLITZ AND GLAMOUR

At first glance, the Tony® Award-winning musical La Cage Aux Folles is a fabulously flamboyant production showcasing gay cross dressing nightclub performers. But it is also a compelling love story which, in the words of the one who wrote the show, undergirds his assertion that "love, commitment and family belong to all people."

Since its debut and initial run, the acclaimed show has been revived in seemingly more reincarnations than a Buddhist's soul. There is no expiration date for this show. Its relevance is timeless as is its appeal to all audiences. Now, 11 years after its previous sold-out run at Riverside Theatre, La Cage Aux Folles returns to the Stark Stage March 10-29.

With music and lyrics by Jerry Herman of Mame and Hello. Dolly fame and a libretto by Harvey Fierstein (Torch Song Trilogy, Hairspray, Fiddler on the Roof), La Cage Aux Folles previewed in 1983 in Boston with some trepidation, considering it was playing before an audience assumed to be conservative. the "Proper Bostonians" didn't pan or ban it, but instead embraced the musical which opened on Broadway shortly thereafter.

La Cage Aux Folles centers on St. Tropez drag nightclub master of ceremonies Georges and his partner, Albin, who stars as the irrepressible drag queen Zaza. The pair is in a long-term romantic relationship and lives in an apartment above the club.

Georges has a son - Jean-Michel - from an earlier tryst with Sybil who ceded the child's custody to Georges' care and Albin's "mothering." Things get topsy-turvy when Jean-Michel announces he is engaged to a girl with ultra-conservative parents and told them that Georges is a retired diplomat.

"Mother" Albin poses another thorny dilemma which leads to deep hurt and rejection before Albin's sense of self and dignity teach Jean-Michel that while Zaza may be an illusion, his parental love and family commitment are not.

A motion picture version of the musical directed by Mike Nichols and starring Robin Williams and Nathan Lane in the lead male roles was released in 1996. The Birdcage was a drag club with a South Miami Beach setting and a corresponding story line. The movie became an international hit and grossed \$185 million.





VETERAN PERFORMER AND RIVERSIDE ALUM BECOMES ALBIN/ZAZA

James Beaman - whose extensive on-stage career has included Shakespearean works, cabaret and three previous Riverside Theatre shows - plays Albin in the Riverside Theatre production, a part he last played in 2007 at the Ogunquit (Maine) Playhouse. Beaman paid homage to the show and its creators as well as to Riverside Theatre officials.

"I feel such excitement and gratitude for having the opportunity to perform this life-affirming classic. I love this role. Albin is far more than the farce character he was in the original French play and films. Because of Harvey Fierstein, he is also an authentic expression of what it means to be true to oneself and to shape a life around that authenticity," Beaman said.

Beaman said that Herman "wrote things that are full of heart" in the grand manner of Lerner and Loewe and Rodgers and Hammerstein who Herman revered.

"What I love about Jerry (Herman) are the stories he tells – the people (like Auntie Mame, Dolly Levi and Albin) who are outside the mainstream and march to their own drummer to confront stuffy morals and bust them open.

"It forces (other) people to step out of their comfort zone and deal with them with a spirit of joy," Beaman said. "Jerry Herman's message was 'take a chance'. Live life fully and authentically. Get out there. La Cage Aux Folles is a piece about love, acceptance and family – it's an incredible love story."

A SHOW FOR ALL

It takes artistically and emotionally gifted people to craft a French farce play by Jean Poiret into the rollicking and the heart-warming musical *La Cage Aux Folles*. The show's premiere in the early 80's was both bold and brave.

La Cage Aux Folles characters in drag were no sissies, but rather brilliantly sequined and impeccably made-up warriors in a battle for equality, recognition and acceptance. In the Act I finale, Herman's song "I Am What I Am" became a show stopper and, perhaps more importantly, an anthem of affirmation and empowerment for a community which desperately needed its message of self-worth.

Herman, who recently died at age 88 in Miami, and was eulogized in the media by Fierstein with whom Herman had a 40-year collaborative and personal relationship.

"We lost one of the greats. I cannot thank him enough for his love, trust, encouragement, support and laughter.

"I'm a happy man who writes the way I want to write."

"He wrote the kind of melody that sticks to your heart and soul kind of the way a good meal sticks to your stomach and ribs, you know? They just fill you up mostly with joy because he had so much joy in him," Fierstein said.

Herman himself described his songs as "the simple, hummable show tune." And if some critics thought his work had a "schmaltzy" quality, then Herman argued that the bedrock anchoring American musical theatre was the singable, hummable and ultimately unforgettable show tune.

"I'm a happy man who writes the way I want to write," Herman told *The New York Times*. "If I had the choice of being the most brilliant and sophisticated writer that ever came down the pike, or being the simple melodic songwriter that I am, I would still have chosen the latter."

Audiences agreed and decades after show premieres still hum songs that affectionately became "ear worms." Hello, Doll-ee... Herman made theatrical history by being the first composer-lyricist to have three musicals run for more than 1,500 performances, according to The Times.

FIERSTEIN PLAYS THE ROLE HE WROTE

In the early days of Fierstein's performing career, he, too, performed as a drag queen. And though in 1983 at age 28 he was too young to play the part of Albin/Zaza, he assumed the role during a 2010 Tony Awardwinning revival of the show.

In a 2011 interview on the PBS "Theater Talk" program, Fierstein said that agreeing to play the part of Albin in a show revival now seemed logical given that he had written the part and was now old enough to play it.

He described some aspects of Albin's personalities as "Zaza, then the insecure, chubby hubby and then the fully-formed person who emerges as mother – this fully-formed person who is the heart of Albin and the guts of Zaza. La Cage is Zaza's world."

Fierstein reminisced about the 1983 Boston previews.

"We were doing something that had never been done before and we didn't know what the reaction would be. It was unbelievably thrilling," Fierstein said.

Audiences around the world continue to agree.



Jerry Herman was born in Manhattan to musically-inclined, middle class Jewish parents. He learned to play the piano at an early age and his parents encouraged his musical talents. After graduation from the University of Miami, he moved to New York where he started his illustrious career in theatre. His Broadway shows include:





Playwright Stephen Sachs takes this true story and turns it into an uproarious and thought-provoking play about a collusion of class attitudes and cultures.

Based on the smash hit film, the breathtakingly romantic thriller follows Secret Service agent turned bodyguard, Frank Farmer, when he is hired to protect superstar Rachel Marron from an unknown stalker. Featuring songs made famous by Whitney Houston, *The Bodyguard* includes "Queen of the Night," "So Emotional," "One Moment in Time," "Saving All My Love For You," "I Have Nothing," and one of the best-selling songs of all time, "I Will Always Love You."

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Riverside's final production of the 2019-2020 season is *The Bodyguard*. The musical, a co-production with the Walnut Street Theatre in Philadelphia, will perform in Vero Beach for three weeks then transfer to the Walnut Street for an additional two months of shows.

For the previous seven years, Walnut Street and Riverside have collaborated on their final productions of the season sharing expenses and creating an incredible experience for both Vero Beach and Philadelphia audiences.

The Bodyguard was chosen at the urging of Walnut Street's artistic director, Bernard Havard, who was greatly impressed when he saw the production in London's West End.

Based on a 1992 movie starring Whitney Houston and Kevin Costner, *The Bodyguard* follows a popular singer, Rachel Marron, in danger from an unknown stalker who is threatening to kill her. Frank Farmer, a retired Secret Service agent, is hired to protect her. The film was the second highest grossing film worldwide in 1992, with \$441 million in ticket sales.

The movie soundtrack sold 45 million copies worldwide, the highest ever. Two of the songs, "I Have Nothing" and "Run to You," were nominated for Oscars. "Queen of the Night" and "I'm Every Woman" became hits while "I Will Always Love You," a Dolly Parton song, logged 14 weeks at number one on the music charts.

The musical adaptation of *The Bodyguard* was written by Alexander Dinelaris and opened at the Adelphi Theatre in the West End in December 2012. It played through August, 2014, when the theatre was booked for another show. Because of the size of the cast, sets and production, it was not feasible

to move to another location in London at that time. The show received numerous Olivier nominations, Britain's equivalent to Broadway's Tony® Awards, including for Best New Musical, Best Actress in a Musical, Best Set Design, and Best Supporting Role in a Musical. The show was so successful, it enjoyed a revival on West End in 2016.

The show has performed extensively throughout the United States, Europe, China, Japan and Korea and has received wonderful reviews from critics, who have stated that the music features the most energetic and catchy pop songs ever written.

The Bodyguard begins when Rachel's manager hires a new bodyguard after receiving deranged death threats from a stalker. Rachel is unimpressed when she meets Frank, believing herself safe. Frank develops a fatherly relationship with Rachel's son Fletcher, while her sister Nicki becomes infatuated with Frank.

Rachel and Frank continue to clash as Frank tries to prevent her from attending dangerous outings and performances. However, during one of Rachel's performances, Frank saves her from the stalker's knife, and she finally agrees to stay at home or have Frank as an escort wherever she goes. The two begin a romantic relationship after one of their nights out, which leads to Frank being replaced as Rachel's bodyguard. Can the new bodyguard keep Rachel safe?

Riverside's production features Cheaza Figueroa as Rachel Marron, who follows a smash hit turn in the 2019 production at Boston's North Shore Musical Theatre.



Cheaza Figueroa was born and raised in Southern California and aspired to be a singer and actress from a very young age. She often performed in talent shows as a young girl, alongside her mother, a former Ikette with Ike and Ting Turner.

Her performing career steadily progressed to commercials, trade shows, modeling, and television appearances on shows including: "City Guys," "The View," "The X Factor," "Extra," and "South of Nowhere." She was in the film Bring It On; In It To Win It and has been featured on albums with Wayne Brady, Drake, and Natasha Beddingfield. She's graced prestigious stages from Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Center in Washington DC, to the Las Vegas Strip. Cheaza was the lead singer/host for one of the Strip's hottest shows, Peepshow, for over four years at Planet Hollywood Resort and Casino.

During her time in Las Vegas, she has also been featured in many magazines and publications and has shared the stage and recorded with Jon Secada, All-4-One, Marie Osmond, Barry Manilow and many more. Cheaza just completed filming a feature film, Temporary Forevers, which will be released in 2020.
